

Nas'alu l-llāha an yubārik lanā fi yawmi 'āshūrā'a ghadan huwa yawmu 'āshūrā', al-ladhī natadhakkaru fihi ba'da ni'ami l-llāhi 'ala n-nās:

Tomorrow is the day of ASHURA when we commemorate the benefi ts that Allah has bestowed on us humans:

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

يَا قَابِلَ تَوْبَةِ آدَمَ يَوْمَ عَاشُورَاءَ

O You who accepted the repentance of Adam on this day of Ashura;

yā qābila tawbati ādama yawma 'āshūrā'

يَا فَارِجَ كَرْبِ ذِي النُّونِ يَوْمَ عَاشُورَاءَ

O You who delivered Jonah from his burden on this day of Ashura;

yā fārija karbi Dhi n-nūni yawma 'āshūrā'

يَا جَامِعَ شَمْلِ يَعْقُوبَ يَوْمَ عَاشُورَاءَ

O You who reunited Jacob on this day of Ashura;

yā jāmi'a shamli Ya'qūba yawma 'āshūrā'

يَا سَامِعَ دَعْوَةِ مُوسَى وَهَارُونَ يَوْمَ عَاشُورَاءَ

O You who heard the plea of Moses and Aaron on this day of Ashura;

yā sāmi'a da'wati Mūsā wa Hārūna yawma 'āshūrā'

يَا مُغِيثَ إِبْرَاهِيمَ مِنَ النَّارِ يَوْمَ عَاشُورَاءَ

O You who rescued Abraham from the fire on this day of Ashura;

yā mughītha Ibrāhīma mina n-nāri yawma 'āshūrā'

يَا رَافِعَ إِدْرِيسَ إِلَى السَّمَاءِ يَوْمَ عَاشُورَاءَ

O You who raised Idris to heaven on this day of Ashura;

Yā rāf i'a Idrīsa ilā s-samā'i yawma 'āshūrā'

يَا مُجِيبَ دَعْوَةِ صَالِحٍ فِي النَّاقَةِ يَوْمَ عَاشُورَاءَ

O You who answered the plea of Salih with a she-camel on this day of Ashura;

Yā mujība da'wati Ṣāliḥ f i n-nāqati yawma 'āshūrā'

يَا نَاصِرَ سَيِّدِنَا مُحَمَّدٍ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ يَوْمَ عَاشُورَاءَ

O You who helped our Master Muhammad (salla llāhu ta ala 'alayhi wa sallama) on this day of Ashura;

Ya nāṣira sayidina Muḥammadin ﷺ yawma 'āshūrā'.

Wa qad awṣā n-nabiyy bi ṣalātin yawma 'āshūrā' tatakawwanu min arba'ati raka'āt fi kulli rak'atin ba'da l-fātiḥa naqra'u sūrata l-ikhhlāshi aḥada 'ashara marra, wa naqūlu ba'da ṣ-ṣalāti sab'īna marra: „ḥasbuna l-llāhu wa ni'ma l-wakil.“

The Prophet \* advises to perform a special prayer on the day of Ashura, consisting of four Raka'ats, and to recite Suratu l-ikhhlās eleven times in each one after the Fatiḥa; and to say „Hasbuna Llahu wa ni'ma l-wakil“ (3:173) 70 times after the prayer.
