## QUWWATU N-NIYYA

Lammā kāna l-insānu ḍa'īfan, kamā qāla lllāh: "wa khuliqa l-insānu ḍa'īfa": faraḍa l-llāhu 'alaynā, an na'qida n-niyya qabla l-qiyāmi bi l-'amal, wa n-nuṭqu bihā sunna.

Wa bi n-niyya yaftaḥu l-llāhu lanā bāban wāsi', ḥattā takūnu ladaynā l-qudratu 'alā t-tanfīdh.

"Qull inna şalāti wa nusuki wa maḥyāya wa mamātī li l-llāhi rabbi l-'ālamīn lā sharīka lah" (6:162)

Iʻqidi n-niyya qabla l-qiyāma bi ayyi ʻamal, wa ijʻal ṣalātaka wa ṣawmaka wa maḥyāka wa mamātaka li l-llāh waḥdah.

Fa yakūnu l-llāhu maʻak wa yuʻṭīka l-quwwa kamā anqadha Ibrāhīma mina n-nār.

## THE POWER OF NIYYAH

Because we humans are weak, as Allah said: "wa khuliqa l-insānu ḍa'īfa": Allah has made it our duty to seize Niyyah before performing an action. To say this, is Sunnah.

With Niyyah, Allah opens a wide door for us, and He commands that we receive the power we need to realise the intended.

"Say: , Surely my Prayer, my acts of worship, and my living and my dying are for Allah alone, the Lord of the whole universe. He has no associate."

Make the intention before the realisation of an action. Make your prayers and fasting, make your life and death for Allah alone.

Then He will stand by you and give you strength, just as He saved Ibrahim (as) from the fire.
