Qāla n-nabiyy ﷺ: yaṭṭali‘u l-llāhu ilā jamī‘i khalqih laylata n-niṣfi min sha‘bān fa yaghfiru li jamī‘i khalqih illā li mushrik aw mushāḥin.

The Prophet ﷺ said: „Allah looks upon all His creation in the night of the middle of the month of Sha‘bān and forgives all His creation except the mushrik and the one who is in strife.

Wa qāla n-nabiyy ﷺ: idhā kānat laylatu n-niṣfi min sha‘bān, fa qūmu laylaha wa ṣūmu nahāraha.

And the Prophet ﷺ said: When the night comes to the middle of the Sha‘bān pray at night and fast if possible the day before.

Fa inna l-llāha yanzilu fiha li ghurūbi sh-shams ilā s-samā‘i d-dunyā, fa yaqūlu:

And when Allah descends to the lowest heaven at sunset that night, He asks:

„Alā min mustaghfirin fa aghfira lah?“

„Is there anyone who asks for forgiveness that I forgive him?“

„Alā mustarziqun fa arzuqahu?“

„Is there anyone who asks for provision that I provide for him?“

„Alā mubtalan fa u‘āfih?“

„Is there someone who suffers from hardship that I deliver him from it?“

„Alā kadhā ... alā kadhā?“ — ḥattā yaṭlu‘a l-fajr.

„Is there this or that, he asks until dawn.“

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Inshā‘allāh satakūnu laylata n-niṣfi min sha‘bān laylata l-aḥad

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Inshā‘allāh, this Night of the middle of the Sha‘bān will be the night to Sunday.
