



Rawā Ibn Khuzayma (rh) ‘an Salmān al-Fārisī (R) qāl: khaṭabana rasūlu l-llāh ﷺ fi ākhir yaumin min sha‘bān fa qāl:

„Ayyuha n-nās qad aḏallakum shahrūn ‘aẓīm, shahrūn mubārak, shahrūn fihi laylatun khayrun min alfi shahr. Ja‘ala l-llāhu ṣiyāmahu farīḏa, wa qiyāmu laylihi taṭawwu‘an.

Man taqarraba fihi bi khiṣlatin mina l-khayr, kāna ka man addā farīḏatan fima siwāh, wa man addā fihi farīḏatan, kāna ka man addā sab‘īna farīḏatan fima siwāh.

Wa huwa shahrūn awwalahu raḥmah wa awsaṭuhu maghfirah wa ākhiruhu ‘itqun mina n-nār. Man khaffafa ‘an mamlūkin ghafara l-llāhu lah wa a‘taqahu mina n-nār.“

Ayyuha l-ikhwatu l-kirām, assalamu aleikum! Kalima ‘ani t-tarāwīḥ hādha l-‘ām: Mithla l-‘āmi l-māḏī, nurīdu an naltaqī yawmiyyan li nuṣallī thamāni raka‘āt wa l-witr.

Lā yujadu taḥdīd li ‘addadi l-mushārikīn wa yumkin li kulli al usra al-mushāraka.

Wa sa tabda’ ṣalātu t-tarāwīḥ min yawmi l-ithnayn ath-thāni ‘ashar min April inshaAllah

Ibn Khuzaimah (rh) reported that Salman al-Farsi (ra) said: „The Messenger of Allah (saw) gave us the following speech on the last day of Sha‘ban:

„O people, there is now coming upon you a great month, a blessed month, a month in which there is a night better than a thousand months. Allah has made fasting in it obligatory and standing in the night (in Tarawih) is optional.

Whoever comes in it with a virtuous act will be like one who has performed a Fard act outside (this month), and whoever performs a Fard act will be like one who has performed seventy Fard acts outside (this month).

And it is a month whose first part is mercy, whose middle part is forgiveness and whose last part is freedom from the fire. Whoever removes the burden from his servant, Allah will forgive him and free him from the Fire.“

Esteemed brothers, As-salamu alaikum! A word about the Tarawih this year: like last year we want to meet for Tarawih at the same time throughout - at nine o‘clock - and pray eight Rakats and the Witr together.

There is no limit to the number of participants for us, so whole family can take part.

The first Tarawih should be insha Allah next Monday, 12 April.
