

Ramadan approuching.

Qul „al-ḥamdu li-llāhi“ „...qiyāman wa qu‘ūdan wa ‘alā junūbihim...„ – qulha fi ṣ-ṣabāḥi, wa l-masā’, qulha bi s-stiḥḍār: Allāhu ḥādirī, Allāhu nāzirī, Allāhu shāhidī, Allāhu ma‘ī – qulhā shākiran wa l-llāhu sa yumṭiruka bi sa‘ādatin lā tūṣaf.

wa fi l-yawmi l-ākhirī sawfa yas’al: „ayna l-ḥāmidūn?“ – fa yajibu an nakūna qādirīna ‘ala an naqūl: „hā naḥnu!“
