— *Fa man yuridi l-llāhu an yahdiyahu yashrah ṣadrahu li l-islām* —

When Alllāhu JJ wishes someone guidance, He opens his heart to Islam. [Qur'an (6:125)]

fa yuḥalliqa l-qalbu mithla ṭ-ṭā'ir, wa lākin idhā lam yaṣ'ad qalbuka, fa lā dā'i li l-qalaq awi sh-shakk. Istamirr wa lā tasma' li sh-shayṭān.

Then the heart rises like a bird. But when your heart no longer flies up, there is no cause for worry or doubt. Just go on and do not listen to Shayṭān.

Idhā arāda l-llāhu an yahdiya insān, ya-shrah ṣadrahu li l-islām. Fa yakūnu qalbuhi sa'idan bi an wajada hādha ṭ-ṭarīq. — Wa yakūnu qalbuhi fariḥan. Wa lā tajidu hādhi-hi s-sa'ādata fī makānin ākhar. Yabdū kulla shay'in jamīlan wa kāmilan.

When Allah wants to give someone hidayat, He opens his heart to Islam. His heart will be very happy to find this path. — The heart will be fresh and very happy. The heart will be fresh and very joyful. You cannot find this felicity in any other place. Everything appears to be beautiful and perfect.

Kathīrun mina n-nāsi sa'idū bi dhālik wa yaqūlūna: laqad wajadna ṭ-ṭarīq. Allahu sāqahu ilā hādha ṭ-ṭarīq, lā budda an yakūna sa'idan. Wa yukmilu hādha ṭ-ṭarīq wa lā yaqūlu hādha wa dhāka. Wa laqad sami'na min ba'di n-nās, wa ayḍan min ahli ṭ-ṭarīqa fi l-bidāya kunnā su'adā'a wa kunnā nuṣalli l-layla wa ghayrih. Wa l-āna tawaqaffnā fi l-bidāya 'indamā razaqana l-llāhu hādha kunnā su'adā'a, wa lākin al-ān ... — Yajibu an na'lama anna hādha shay'un mawjūd. Awliyā'a l-llāhi lā yas'alūna hādhi l-as'ila wa yash'urūna dā'iman bi s-sa'ādati fī qulūbihim. Lā yajūzu an nuṭī'a sh-shayṭān.

Many people have this happiness, and they say, we have found the way. - Allah has put him on this path, he must be happy, he must continue on this path and not say this or that. We have heard from people, also from Tariqat people, in the beginning we were so happy and we did everything, night prayers and so on, but now we don't have that. In the beginning, when Allah gave this, we felt very happy. But now... — But we should know that it is always there. The Awliya Llah do not talk in this way, they always feel happiness in their hearts. We must not listen to Shayṭān.

Law lam yuridi l-llāhu laka an tasluka hādha ṭ-ṭarīq, sa tash'uru bi ḍiqin fī ṣadrik — inna ḥalatahum takūnu sayī'atan wa yash'urūna bi l-ḥuzn, lā yumkinu an yus'idahum shay' la'anna l-llāha qad tarakahum li l-kufr. Law kunta hākadha fa lan takūna sa'idan abadan, la'anna l-qalba mughlaq.

If Allah does not want you to go this way, you will feel pressure in your chest. — Their condition is bad and sad. Nothing can make them happy because Allah makes them go into disbelief kufr. If you are like that, you will never be happy because your heart is closed.

Idhā hadāna l-llāhu lā budda an nakūna shākirīna wa su'adā'. Bi hādha faqaṭ mumkin an tastamirra kamā kunta min qabl, la'anna ḥayātanā lā yumkin an tarji'a lil-warā'. Idhā fa'alta shay'an sayī'an, istaghfiri l-llāha thumma s-stamirr.

When Allah gives us hidayat, we must be grateful and happy. You only go forward in this way and do not look at how you were before. Because our life cannot go back. If you do something bad, ask Allah for forgiveness and move on.
