Verily, it is You, the All-Knower, the All-Wise."

"Subhanaka," said the angels, "You are Subhan." We don't know anything, whatever You teach we know that. We can't know what you don't teach.

So, your friend that you spend time with should be a good servant of Allah. Find a good servant, make sure he is a servant whom Allah loves, because whoever loves a beloved servant of Allah, Allah loves him. This is a rule, never changes.

Whoever loves a servant whom Allah doesn't love, Allah doesn't love him either. Who does not love a servant Allah doesn't love, Allah loves him. Allah doesn't love someone who loves a servant not loved by Allah.

Look, this protects you from any kind of danger all your life. You may have a good life here and hereafter. Just one issue. Love the one Allah loves. Of course there are many servants, whom Allah loves. He loves our Prophet the most. That's why they said, "Hubbu n-Nabi wajibun."

You can reach the love of Allah through the Prophet

Anyone who saw him if they couldn't leave him. Why? He represents the love of Allah, that love he has. Allah gave him that love from His love. He gave it directly, without any means.

Find a beloved servant of Allah and walk with him, don't ever love someone Allah doesn't love. It is terrible. This is an important point to pay attention for those who hope to live a long life. They don't teach such things at school, university, college, of course. "No need," they say. Nevertheless, this is the most necessary thing in life.
