

Aḥyānan yakūnu mina l-jayyidi an narā madhā yaf'alu l-ākharūna wa kayfa yufakkirūn.

Fī khuṭba li s-sayyid farakhān amāma l-jumhūri qāla: „īsa, ‘alayhi s-salām, atā ilā hādha l-‘ālam li yunqidhana min dhunūbina.“

Wa lākinnaka lā tajidu ayya makān fī l-kitābi l-muqaddasi yaqūlu fīhi annahu masīḥī, wa lā fī ayy injīlin mina l-anājīli l-arba‘a.

Arinī ayna qāla anā bābtist, aw annaka law lam takun bābtist lan tad khula l-janna?

Wa idhā lam yakun hādha mawjūdun fī l-injīl, fa limādha huwa mawjūdun fī afwāḥikum?

‘īsa tamma ta‘mīduhu min qibal yūḥannā, wa lākinnahu laysa tābi‘an li l-kanīsa l-mi‘midāniyya. Wa lam yaqul abadan anā mitudist.

Innamā qāla, ana ṭ-ṭaqrīqu wa l-ḥaqīqatu wa l-ḥayāh, wa lam yaqul abadan anā kāthūlikī. Innahu ‘ālamīyy. – Limādha tuqātilūna ba‘ḍakum taḥti asmā’in huwa lam yaqulha?

Al-masīḥu qāla laysat mashī‘ati allatī takūnu wa lākin mashī‘atuk. Laqad amaranī rabbī wa mā ya‘murunī bihi aḥibbu an af'al.

Wa hādha huwa aḥsana waṣf in li l-islām. Innahu ya‘nī l-khuḍū‘i l-kāmil li irādati l-llāh.

Wa mina l-mufriḥ an yajida l-ḥaqqu ṭarīqah, bi ghaḍḍi n-naḥar ‘an man yaqūlu dhālik

Sometimes it's good to look around at what other people are doing and what they think.
